Dear Parents/Guardians:

I am writing you at this time because your child is in grade 12. The final year of high school is exciting for senior students, and for their parents too, because it includes planning for the important transition to post-secondary life: this may include college, work or university.

It is also exciting because it culminates with important milestone events such as Senior Prom and Graduation. I offer the information in this package to help you plan with your child for events that lead up to graduation day.

On **Monday, October 28th, at 9:45 a.m.** there will be a mandatory meeting for all students intending to graduate this year. We will address the contents of this information package and highlight important events that lie ahead.

Another very important date for graduates is Thursday, April 23rd, 2020: "Grade 12 Day". On this day, grade 12 students will be called down to the Guidance area. Staff will be on hand to assist students with the following:

- Grad Fee Payment \$40.00 – Confirmation of intent to attend convocation
- Grad Gown Sizing
- Final Valedictorian and Salutatorian Voting
- Graduation Biography/Award Application Form
- Grad Retreat Forms Handed In
- Last day to submit a Community Involvement Hours form
- Prom Ticket Sales (an additional Prom information sheet is attached)

It is important that grade 12 students plan to be at school this day. Setting this day as one clear deadline for a number of important tasks should assist students by simplifying their planning calendar. Knowing this date early in the school year should also help them budget for the payment of the grad fee and purchase of Prom tickets.


